FIVE SAFETY TIPS TO SAVE LIVES AND PROPERTY

- Make sure that you have a number of smoke detectors and check them (MONTHLY). A large number of detectors are installed but don't work.
- 2. Be sure you have a working carbon monoxide detector on each floor of your house.
- 3. House numbers are very important please post your number on the front of your home. In the event of a medical or fire emergency there is a good chance that you will not be found without house numbers.
- 4. Have an escape plan for your entire family. Plan on a location somewhere outside of the house where everyone can meet.
- 5. Keep your electrical system working properly. Circuit breakers must be turned on and off at least twice a year to keep them working properly. Refrain from using lead cords. Also refrain from using electric space heaters with lead cords. Plugging directly into the receptacle is the best practice.
